

PALESTINE APPEAL BACKED

Orthodox Rabbis Form Council to Speed Rescue Work

Orthodox rabbis have formed a council to enlist support of orthodox Jewish groups in the nationwide United Palestine Appeal for the rescue and rehabilitation of large numbers of the surviving Jews of Europe through mass migration to Palestine, it was announced yesterday. Rabbi Joseph D. Solowichick of Boston is chairman of the council.

The United Palestine Appeal finances the development of the Jewish settlement in Palestine. This year the organizations require \$25,000,000 to provide for Palestine agencies supported by the appeal.

The Orthodox Council called upon 3,000 orthodox Jewish congregations throughout the nation to dedicate the Passover holiday, beginning at sundown Wednesday, to prayers and appeals for the building of the Jewish settlement through the United Palestine Appeal.
